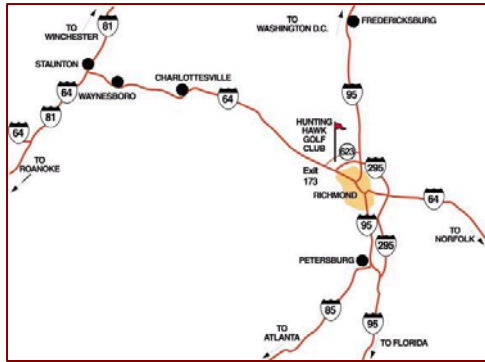

Located in Northwest Richmond in Western Hanover County on Rt. 623 (Ashland Road) between Pouncey Tract Road and Rt. 33.

- From I-64 East (Charlottesville), take Exit 173; go North (left) on Rt. 623 for 3.2 miles.
- From I-64 West (Richmond), take Exit 173; go North (right) on Rt. 623 for 3.2 miles.
- From I-295 toward Charlottesville, take exit 51; go North on Nuckols Rd. 5 miles, go right on Rt. 623 (Ashland Road), Hunting Hawk is one mile ahead on the right.
- From Northern Virginia, take I-95 South to Exit 92 Ashland; turn right, take a left at the 3rd stoplight onto Rte. 1 South, turn right onto Ashcake Rd. at the Luck Chevrolet Dealership and Sheetz Gas Station, Ashcake Rd. becomes Ashland Rd. and Hunting Hawk is approximately 9.3 miles from Rte. 1 on the left.
