## THE WYNDHAM VIRGINIA BEACH OCEANFRONT

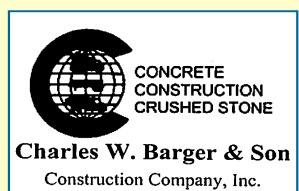
