

VTCA Aggregate Producer Scholarship

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

The VTCA Aggregate Producer Scholarship is funded and supported by the Aggregate Producer membership of the Virginia Transportation Construction Alliance.

Objective:

To provide financial assistance to qualified and deserving students enrolled full-time in Virginia institutions of higher learning specializing in curriculums related to the aggregate industry. Eligible programs include civil engineering, construction management, geology and mining and mineral engineering. Successful applicants will have a demonstrated desire to pursue a career within the aggregates industries.

Eligibility:

1. Applicants must be citizens of the United States.
2. Applicants must be enrolled full-time at an accredited Virginia college or university and must be in one of the following programs:
 - ◆ Civil Engineering
 - ◆ Construction Management
 - ◆ Geology
 - ◆ Mining and Mineral Engineering
3. This program is for undergraduates only. Applicants must be a college freshman, sophomore or junior.
4. A recipient of a scholarship in one year may apply the following year.

Application Process:

Candidates must submit:

1. A 250-500 word essay which includes the following:
 - a. An explanation of why you are interested in pursuing a career in the aggregates industries and
 - b. Describe your level of interest in interning with a VTCA member firm during one summer.
2. A VTCA Aggregate Producer Scholarship application form.
3. Current college transcripts.
4. Reference form completed by a member of the applicant's academic community.

Entries must be received by April 15, 2010 for the 2010-2011 scholarship.

Evaluation and Selection:

The VTCA Aggregate Producer Scholarship Awards Committee will evaluate the applications and select the successful candidate. The criteria for selection include academic performance, employment experience, extracurricular and leadership activities and a demonstrated interest in the aggregates industries. Selections will be announced in June. In the event no qualified students apply, the committee reserves the right to not award the scholarship.
